I understand and agree to be held responsible for adhering to the regulations, policies, and procedures stated in the Institute for Shipboard Education's (ISE) Voyager's Handbook. I understand that I am responsible to review and become familiar with the contents of this handbook to include the Student Code of Conduct and Policies and Procedures (e.g. alcohol, drug, sexual misconduct, harassment, independent and out-of-country travel, etc.)

I understand that I have the opportunity to ask questions of the ISE staff in the corporate office and/or the voyage staff (e.g. the Dean of Student Life, Resident Directors, etc.) about any portion of the Voyager's Handbook, to include the Student Code of Conduct and Policies and Procedures, which is unclear to me.

I further understand that violation of the Student Code of Conduct will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the Semester at Sea program. Concurrent with more serious disciplinary matters (i.e. issuance of the sanction of probation, expulsion in abeyance, or expulsion), I understand that program administrators may notify my parents/guardian/emergency contacts and home institution administrator (I.e. director of international education and/or chief conduct officer).

If dismissed for a violation of the Code of Student Conduct, I understand that I will be academically withdrawn from Colorado State University and will receive no academic credit. Further, I understand that no refund will be paid for any unused portion of the voyage. I also understand and agree that if I am dismissed, ISE is not responsible for my safety, arrangements, or costs either shore-side or for my return home.

Consent for Searches and Testing
